**BALL CARRYING**

William Dudley, of the Pittsburgh Steelers, who in 1942 led the league in ball carrying with 696 yards in 162 attempts and then went off to war as a B-29 pilot in the Pacific, repeated in 1946 with 604 yards in 146 attempts.

The former University of Virginia luminary registered 59 yards more than Pat Harder, who in his first year of play in the league nosed out the 1945 champion, Steve Van Buren, of Philadelphia by 16 yards. A sensational performance against the Chicago Bears in the final game of the season in which he gained 112 yards brought the former Wisconsin star into the runnerup position.

Green Bay won team honors for the first time with 1,765 yards, a total that exceeded the gains made by the second place Chicago Bears, by 46 yards. Ted Fritsch and Walt Schlinkman, carrying the ball nearly half the time, contributed 823 yards to the Packers' total. Los Angeles, defending champion, and the Cardinals, third and fourth respectively compiled the best average, gaining 4.1 yards each per rushing attempt.

INTERCEPTIONS

Bill Dudley added the interception title to his ground gaining championship by snaring ten enemy passes and returning them 242 yards. Against Washington he intercepted a pass and ran 80 yards for a touchdown. His 24.2 average on returns of interceptions while not the highest in the league was notable because of the number of interceptions he made.

Bob Davis, of Boston, veteran halfback, finished second to Dudley with seven interceptions, one more than the third place player, Gil Steinke, of Philadelphia. Fourth place was shared by Herman Rohrig, Green Bay, Frank Liebel, New York, and Bob Waterfield, Los Angeles, each of whom garnered five passes. Rohrig led in returns with 134 yards, an average of 26.8 yards.

Tom Harmon, former Michigan star and a Los Angeles newcomer made the longest return of the season, an 85-yard run against Green Bay.

Philadelphia won the team title in interceptions with an average of .118 percent of all passes thrown against it. Green Bay was second and Washington third. Both Philadelphia and Green Bay averaged 16.6 yards per interception.

PUNT RETURNS

Bill Dudley, of Pittsburgh, added the punt return title to the two others he won during 1946, ground gaining and pass intercepting, by making 27 returns, more than any other punt receiver in the 55 championship games, for an average of 14.2 yards per return.

Steve Bagarus, of Washington, was second and Brosh Pritchard, of Philadelphia, third. The former returned 18 punts for an average of 10.7 yards and the latter 12 for a 13.8 average. Dave Ryan, 1945 champion, finished sixteenth as he shared the punt handling with Bill DeCorrevont.

Philadelphia won the team championship with a percentage of 61.0. Returns by Eagle players accounted for 504 yards.

LATERAL PASSING

Bill Dudley, Pittsburgh, annexed his fourth title of the 1946 season when he finished first in lateral passing. He threw five and completed four for 13 yards. His longest gain was six yards.

Bosh Pritchard, Philadelphia, was second with four completions out of five thrown with Westfall, Detroit, third, with three thrown and the same number completed.

The league championship went to Pittsburgh with ten attempts, seven of which were successful. During the season all teams made 52 attempts and completed 45. In 1945 68 were thrown and 64 completed.
