## **Subject:** Family and Consumer Sciences

### **Lesson Title:** Walter Payton Man of the Year Award

#### **Goals/Objectives:**

Students will:

- Define the Hall of Fame Values: Commitment, Integrity, Courage, Respect and Honesty.
- Demonstrate understanding of the traits associated with the Hall of Fame Values.
- Demonstrate understanding of how good character is essential for achieving success in life.
- Be inspired to live more meaningful and effective lives by incorporating new insights regarding good character into their daily lives.
- Learn what it means to be a good teammate in their community and in the world.
- Learn how to give back and serve their community.

#### **National Standards met:**

- **Family and Consumer Sciences:** 7.0-Family and Human Services; 12.0-Human Development; 13.0-Interpersonal Relationships.

#### **Methods/Procedures:**

##### **Prior to Program**

- Students will research about Walter Payton whom the award is named after. Some recommended websites:

- Students can check out some of the other videos on the site as well.
- Students will find a video about one of these award winners from previous years and write down one thing they learned about how this player made the world we live in a better place.
- Students can use Google to search for more information about their selected award winner.



## During Program

- Students will:
  - Discuss the mission/vision/values of the Pro Football Hall of Fame.
  - Discuss what they learned about Walter Payton and his legacy.
  - Share who they selected and one thing they learned about that person.
  - Learn about how the game of football teaches how to commit yourself to something bigger than just yourself.
  - Learn teams not only exist on the field but more importantly in the world.
  - Learn how to give back and serve their community.

## After the Program

- Students can take what they have learned from the pre-program research and the actual program and write or type an essay on what they learned from this experience and then what can they do to make their community a better place.
- Students can present this information to each other during class.
