- Take notes on the presentation collecting facts about the athletes and their accomplishments in more than one sport.
- Conduct research about one of the highlighted athletes of their choice.

Prior to the Program (5-12 School)

During the Program (HOF)

Time Allotted: 40 minutes

Materials/ Resources

- Video of Dual Sports Stars
- Access to the Internet
- Notebooks, notepads, tablets or laptops
- Smart Board or projector if producing a visual presentations

Activities

- (10 minutes) Welcome/Mission/Values
- (20 minutes) Discussion/Presentation and Videos on Dual Sports Stars
- (10 minutes) Question and Answer

Assessment

- Complete Dual Sports Stars summary sheet.

This is the lesson component the instructor will complete with students back at their classroom after the field trip program.

After the Program (5-12 School)

Time Allotted: 30 minutes

Materials/Resources

- Video of Dual Sports Stars
- Access to the Internet
- Notebooks, notepads, tablets or laptops
- Smart Board or projector if producing a visual presentations

Activities

- Students will submit a summary of the presentation in chronological order.
- Students will create an essay on the chosen athlete with information about how the athlete acquired the building blocks for his excellent performance in more than one sport. A teacher created rubric can be used to assess this activity.
- Students will submit an essay comparing and contrasting two dual star athletes along with a compare/contrast chart showing the information in some type of graphic organizer. The essay will be assessed based on a teacher-created rubric.
- Students will submit questions for the athlete's interview and then students will create an
 interview of the athlete in an oral, written, or visual format conveying answers to all questions
 asked. This presentation needs to provide insight into how the athlete accomplished the high level
 of success in the specific sports.

Assessment

Students will be evaluated based on their essay.

Enrichment

- The teacher can also assess student learning during the post-field class discussion.
- The teacher can use a rubric to score each essay.
